Discussion Questions

1. Miki Kamberovic talks about how Roma people have faced identity issues. What are some of the unique factors that create a Roma identity issue? How can understanding their identity in Christ help with these issues?
2. Martin Burrell says, "I felt I probably had more to learn from them than they would have to learn from me." This is a feeling that many missionaries have when they meet the Roma. What can we learn from the Roma and from how God is interacting with them? What might this tell us about how The Spirit works in the world?
3. Although there are many wealthy, educated Roma there are also many marginalized Roma who are living in poverty. How is the church bringing lasting hope and transformation to people who have little or no access to education, jobs, and health care? How is the church affecting change in family structures?
4. The Roma have been marginalized in European society for centuries. Where the church should be the place of reconciliation it has often been complicit in marginalization. How does this happen? Is it possible that your community or even your church is complicit in the marginalization of a particular people group?
